Programs & Horses...

Therapeutic Riding... Each week a new lesson plan is created keeping in mind many aspects such as fun, riding skills, multi-step planning and social engagement. The riders and the horse all look forward to the new experience. I would like to share 2 such lessons, #1 will impress upon you the need for the horse path.

#1 Picture this: In the indoor arena, each rider picks up 4 animals (small beanie babies hidden in buckets and tucked in gates). Then puts them on a barrel that has their name on it, remembering each animal. Now, rides outside to find their animals. The animals are hiding in the corn on a corn stalk, peeking up from the grass and hanging on the fence in the outdoor pen. And they are BIG! Oh the excitement!! To find their snake wrapped around a corn stalk or the lion in the grass engaged ALL, and encouraged great conversations. When we were back inside, each rider, one at a time, eagerly shared with the group what their animals were and where in the field they found them. NOW, imagine a path that goes around the hay fields and into the woods!!

#2 The arena is filled with fun objects to inspire! This lesson had stations set up on barrels in the arena.

Station 3 was to say 3 feelings they have when they ride; Silly ~ Smiley ~ Relaxed Confident ~ Good ~ Nice Pretty Awesome ~ Joy Feels like a second home Calm ~ FREEDOM !



These two lessons are a great example of giving our riders freedom of... balance, movement and expression. HORSES CHANGE LIVES! Riders, Volunteers and businesses have been filling these jars. Funds supporting the horses come from the Riding Celebration, Annual Appeal and Individual Donations.

'Hope With Horses'... horses provide great metaphoric learning, every week 1200 lb horses gently guiding the teens to a new level of self-awareness. They complete the 10 week session by assisting elementary age riders during their therapeutic riding lesson ~ when you help someone else, you truly start helping yourself.

This student walked his horse through an obstacle course without using a lead rope. This was very difficult and very empowering



with a great group discussion on "What are the obstacles in your life?"

'Healing With Horses'...We look forward to another year offering classes to Veterans. Sessions starting up again in February!

The film 'Riding My Way Back' is a documentary about a veteran, a horse and hope. The film project educates, promotes, and brings awareness to the
